As per the UGC norms the cell meets every three months in a year. The cell has introduced very effective innovations both in the academic and non-academic perspective of the college. The cell mainly focused on achieving the prestigious NAAC accreditation with highest grades within a span of two years.

The cell has taken initiative for the participation of our faculty in the five day faculty development program organized by Ramanujan College, Delhi. Nine faculty members from various departments successfully completed the program.

Introduction of Class Log Book and Staff Log Book was another important initiative by the cell. It mainly focused on the periodic assessment of both students and staff.

Two Government colleges were visited by the cell in order to learn the NAAC assessment and accreditation process.

- 1. A team led by principal Dr S A Shajahan along with Dr Mohammad Fazil and Mr Shabeer Ahmed N visited the Govt college Attingal.
- Similarly in the month of November, a team consists of Dr S A Shajahan, Mr Shabeer Ahmed N, Mrs Fajisa Beevi, Miss Allwin D and Mrs Divya visited the Govt College Nedumangad.

The visits were very successful and helped a lot to maintain the reports and files in various departments as per the UGC norms.

Other major Initiatives

- A seven days workshop for the introduction and the acquisition of NAAC accreditation and an assessment was organized both in offline and online mode by Dr Aravind, former Principal, Govt College for Women, TVM, Dr. Toji Dominic IQAC coordinator.
- 2. A faculty member from each department is assigned as coordinator to each items of various criteria and submit a report to the IQAC regarding the DLMC and subsequent actions.
- 3. Students were encouraged to participate in the Young Innovators Program of the Govt of Kerala. About 72 students under 9 teams submitted their innovative ideas in the program. A webinar was also organised by the IQAC on 5/2/ 2022 for our students to give an orientation on YIP. Around 75 participants including teachers and students attended the webinar. The Resource Person of the webinar was Mr Nipun from KDISC, Govt of Kerala. He explained the entire process of YIP registration and also cleared the doubts raised by some of the participants. The Webinar was really informative and helpful for the students and it cleared many apprehensions
 - of our students regarding their eligibility for getting selected in the Young Innovators Program
- 4. Under the IQAC two major events were organized
 - Merit o' National: A ceremony to honour the University rank winners and to the distictive sports and arts performers. The event was inaugurated by Hon. Minister for Education Shri V Sivankutty. The meeting was blessed with the presence of Dr. Rajasree, Hon. Vice Chancellor Dr APJ Technical University and Dr Babujhan, Syndicate Member, University of Kerala.
 - 2. Insight o' National: A project to provide an opportunity for our students to meet the experts from various fields. Adv G R Anil, Hon. Minister for Food and Civil supplies inaugurated the function. Mr Mohammed Safeerulla IAS under took a major session on academics and career opportunities.
- 5. Continuing Education :

Inorder to provide skill training along with curriculum, in association with State Resource Cell, Govt of Kerala, and Diploma course in Computer Application was started. The college campus was recognized as one of the sub centers of the State Resource Cell.

- On Sept 5th, Teacher's Day celebration was organized. Dr Achuthsankar, Dean, Centre for Computational Biology, University of Kerala was the chief guest of the day.

Augment English language skills of the students for developing creative insight and powerful literary talents to accomplish higher ideals of life.







3. Vision of the Department of Social Work:
















TRAINING & PLACEMENT CELL- CAREER GUIDANCE
